Strategic Key Messages: Emergency

Reinforce that the most accurate source of information for the City of Summit during times of emergency is the City of Summit.

- During times of emergency, it is in the best interest of the City to be the most reliable and timely source of information for citizens and members of the business community about the City's response.
- Use of City of Summit style guide recommendations will ensure consistent, accurate messaging.

Endeavor to communicate in a straightforward, timely and efficient manner.

- Citizens want and expect frequent updates.
 - During times of crisis, hourly is acceptable. If new information is available, more frequent updates would be appreciated.
 - In longer term crisis situations, less frequent intervals of communication are acceptable.
 Updates two to three times daily are expected.

Communications should focus on impact on town, residents, and business because that is what people care about.

• "How will this impact me?" and "What do I need to do?" and "What services is the City providing?" are the questions on everyone's mind during an emergency.

Action item: Further development of emergency messages will be crisis specific and conducted in collaboration with the City Administrator and Office of Emergency Management (OEM).

Emergency Situations

Declared emergencies

The City of Summit will declare a state of emergency when events, either natural or manmade, exceed municipal resources as well as those available via mutual aid from nearby towns. Examples of a declared emergency include but are not limited to flooding, hurricanes, tornados, mud slides, blizzards, fires, civil unrest, hazmat incidents, etc.

In the event that a county, state, or federal state of emergency is declared, the City of Summit will adopt a state of emergency as well, and look to mutual aid for any required resources.

Non-declared

A non-declared emergency is a major public inconvenience situation, such as a heavy snowstorm or water main break, that requires city services and personnel beyond routine duties, but does not exceed municipal resources.

The Emergency Management Coordinator and two Deputy Coordinators, Mayor, and City Administrator are involved in the declaration process. The process begins with reviewing the events, followed by

evaluating the impact on the community and the available resources to handle the emergency. This group discusses the situation with the County Emergency Coordinator for input, and when an emergency is declared, it is through the county coordinator.

Communications Vehicles (Emergency)

In emergency situations, the Communications Specialist will utilize a variety of communications vehicles/channels to effectively share information with key constituent groups. These include:

Swiftreach Alerts

Swiftreach serves as the City's official alert system, and is used only when emergency communications are necessary. Alerts are provided by phone, text and email.

Monitor Nixle Alerts

Nixle alerts are distributed by the Police Department by text and email. These include missing or runaway children, traffic advisories, road closures, and non-emergency information such as community events as well. There is a link to Nixle alerts on the Police Department homepage. It could be useful to have a link to a Nixle feed on the City of Summit homepage.

CivicSend

A number of email lists of residential and business community members have been established on the City of Summit website to be utilized for important communications from the City during an emergency situation. This approach is designed to distribute information specific to certain groups of individuals that is not necessary for every resident to know.

News Releases

In emergency situations, news releases play a lesser role but may still be utilized during longer term situations where more comprehensive updates are required. While most media outlets prefer email updates, the Independent Press and nj.com prefer traditional news releases. A list of media contacts is included below.

Emails to members of the media

Emails to members of the media are the best way to get quick coverage during emergency events. Shorter, more frequent updates are what the media want and expect, especially The Alternative Press and Summit Patch. Tips from Town and 365 Things to Do in Summit and New Providence are also included when sending out email updates.

City website "News" section

When information is sent out by news release and email to media outlets, it must also be immediately posted on the City website in the "News" section. Visitors have come to expect up-to-date and timely

information on the homepage. A notification is sent out to subscribers of the chosen News Feed category, with a link to the news feed and relevant information.

Information in the "News" section of the website and shared through news release and email to media outlets should also be posted on the City Facebook and Twitter pages. Many citizens expect to be able to receive breaking news and other important information from the City through its Facebook and Twitter feeds and directed to the City website for more comprehensive information.

Other

The City of Summit Police Department owns and operates an electronic sign board that is utilized during emergency situations. Police car loudspeakers are also available for use during an emergency situation.

The City of Summit utilizes sandwich boards at City Hall and the Summit Train Station providing directions and information to citizens during emergency situations.

Informational fliers are delivered door to door and included in Meals on Wheels deliveries.
