#### 2020 Holiday Schedule and Citywide Events

SUMMIT, N.J., November 18, 2020 – The City of Summit is announcing the following holiday events and schedule changes taking place throughout November and December 2020.

On Sunday, December 6, the Department of Community Programs will host the annual Miracle on Elm Street event, and a holiday tree-lighting with the Summit Area YMCA. Miracle on Elm Street will take place from 1PM to 7PM, with ice skating in the Elm Street parking lot. Hot chocolate and bonfires will be provided for attendees, as well as the option to purchase ingredients to make s'mores. Musical and entertainment acts will perform on the Village Green, including the Pebble Players, a local youth theater group. The tree-lighting will take place at approximately 5:30PM, and the Summit Fire Department will assist with Santa's arrival to the Village Green. Socially-distanced photos with Santa will be offered.

Thursday, November 26; Friday, November 27; and Saturday, November 28; are parking holidays in Summit with no fees required for on-street parking, or parking in municipal lots and garages.

City offices will be closed on Thursday, November 26 and Friday, November 27 in observance of the Thanksgiving holiday, on Friday, December 25 in observance of Christmas, and on Friday, December 31 for the New Year's holiday.

#### **Other Summit Events**

Summit Downtown Inc. will host two events on Saturday, November 28. Small Business Saturday is from 10AM to 5PM in downtown Summit. Many businesses will feature special offers and merchandise for the day. Celebrate in Summit will be held from 1PM to 4 PM, an event to kick off the holiday season in Summit. There will be live music throughout the downtown area, as well as horse and carriage rides beginning at Lyric Park, on the corner of Beechwood Road and Bank Street. All activities are free to the public.

Carriages and Carolers will also begin on Saturday, November 28, and continue throughout December on Saturdays December 5, December 12, and December 19 from 1PM to 4PM. Residents can enjoy holiday music and a free horse and carriage ride around downtown Summit. The boarding location will be Lyric Park, on the corner of Beechwood Road and Bank Street.

The Summit Farmers Market has been extended to mid-December, to include Sundays December 6, 13, and 20 from 9AM to 12PM, in the Park & Shop Lot on the corner of Deforest Avenue and Woodland Avenue. The Farmers Market will be closed on Sunday, November 29 following the Thanksgiving holiday.
