PSE&G and New Jersey American Water Begin Kent Place Boulevard Paving Project December 8

SUMMIT, N.J., December 4, 2020 – Road work on Kent Place Boulevard will begin on Tuesday, December 8 through Saturday, December 12, weather permitting. The project to mill and pave the road follows several months of work by PSE&G and New Jersey American Water to make gas and water line improvements to residential properties on Kent Place Boulevard.

The project will include the milling and paving of Kent Place Boulevard from Passaic Avenue to High Street, and portions of Colonial Road and Madison Avenue near Kent Place Boulevard. Milling will take place on Tuesday, December 8 and Wednesday, December 9. Paving operations will begin on Saturday, December 12 and continue on Monday, December 14, if necessary.

Street closures will be in effect during milling and paving operations. Emergency vehicles will have access at all times, and Summit Police officers will be onsite to direct traffic and assist with local access on affected streets.

Written notifications will be delivered by the paying contractor to all affected property owners. During project work, residents should park on neighboring side streets before 7AM. If it is necessary to leave cars on the street overnight, please contact the Summit Police Department at 908-273-0051 to avoid being ticketed.
